Munich is an economic boomtown and a hotspot for the media. Huge parks and the Isar River make it one of Germany's greenest cities offering a great quality of living. Its mixture of world-class hotels, sprawling parks and cosy beer gardens give Munich an edge over many of its German siblings.

Essentials

- 01 Visit a beer-garden. It's worth a trek to Waldwirtschaft Großhesselohe. It's the most enjoyable beer-garden experience Munich has to offer, with live-jazz and the best spare ribs.
- 02 Climb the 306 stairs of the Alter Peter, a Catholic church with a tower a viewing platform between Marienplatz and Viktualienmarkt. On a bright day, you will have view of more than 100km.
- 03 Admire Munich's river surfers. Located next to the Haus der Kunst (Prinzregentenstraße), watch the Eisbach-Surfers test their skills.
- 04 Rent a car. Amazing lakes and mountains are reachable within a 30-minute ride.
- 05 Forget about a car in the city. The public transport system will get you everywhere and the city is perfect for walking.
